

We are in the process of applying for a mining permit revision for the area described below and would like to request comments from your office in order to proceed with this project.

Warrior Investment Company, Inc. has existing mining operations in Walker County, Alabama. In order to accommodate its business expansion in Walker County, Warrior Investment Company, Inc. wants to add 181 acres at the project site as located in Section 29 & 32, Township 15 South, Range 6 West, on the Goodsprings, Alabama U.S.G.S Quadrangle as found in Walker County, Alabama. The proposed site location is shown on the attached 2000' scale project area map attachment "B".

The proposed project activity consists of 181 acres all of which received a habitat study in June of 2012. 
