
The proposed reclamation plan will use Rye Grass and Browntop Millet as temporary vegetation species and will use, based on seasonal appropriateness, Common Bermuda Grass, Kobe Lespedeza, Fescue, Serala Serica, Crimson Clover and Yuche Arrow Leaf Clover as permanent vegetative cover.

Sedimentation basins will be constructed to control drainage and protect the existing streams flowing from the site and it may be necessary to leave some of these basins as permanent water impoundments. Permanent water impoundments can only be constructed at the site with the landowner and Alabama Surface Mining Commission approval. This will be done on a site by site basis.




